Telephone support and factory-assisted remote troubleshooting is provided without charge during our normal working hours - for the life of the system. SCADA software updates and RTU firmware upgrades are offered free of charge.

Normal Hours Support:

The Customer Service Department are Monday through Friday, 8:00am to 5:00pm EST. To reach a technician during these hours, contact our Customer Service Call Coordinator at 321-259-5009 Ext 1117. The coordinator will open a Service Ticket and assign your call to a Technician. You should receive a call from your assigned technician within 30 minutes. In some states you may be required to contact your local DFS representative for initial support.

After-Hours Support (Emergency On-Call)

For emergency support after regular business hours and holidays, call 321-288-1959. Your call will be forwarded to the designated on-call technician. After-hours support may be invoiced if system access or a site visit is required.

Web-Based Support (Non-Emergency)

Any non-urgent (low priority) issues can be submitted to our Customer Service Department through our online Help Desk. For each incident submitted through Help Desk, data is collected and a ticket is opened. A technician is assigned by the Customer Service Manager following review of the incoming ticket. The Web-based Help Desk is primarily used by customers to monitor open ticket status; however review of past closed ticket information is also available to the user.
